### SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITY

### GENERAL INFORMATION

1. The scholarship is available for either college or vocational training.
2. Scholarships with an accumulative total of \$500.00 - \$1,000 each may be awarded.
3. The scholarship will be paid during the second semester of enrollment for the first year college/vocational student.
4. To receive the awarded scholarship payment, the recipient is to notify the Shenandoah Medical Center Foundation Board upon enrollment in his/her second semester of education.
